Unfortunately, we do not provide office facilities or administrative assistance to Visiting Scholars.

Two weeks prior to your arrival I would ask you to please get in touch with your main collaborator and administrative contact to arrange a SOAS login and email account for you. They will also request to have your SOAS ID/Library card issued, and make sure that all relevant access has been arranged.

As a Visiting Scholar a bench fee is charged. See https://www.soas.ac.uk/research/honorary-appointments for current charges. Bench fee charges are paid via the online store: https://store.soas.ac.uk/product-catalogue/university-services/visiting-bench-fee.

Please be aware that SOAS does not have any residential accommodation of its own, so we ask Visiting Scholars to make their own arrangements. You may find the University of London Accommodation Office helpful: https://housing.london.ac.uk/.
